It was also encouraging to see our third and fourth grade students get to travel to the reservation and play against reservation schools. For most of our third and fourth graders this was their first time to play organized basketball. It was exciting to watch them grow as players and as a team this season.

Many of the schools we play on the reservation are kindergarten through fourth grade elementary schools. Playing these schools allows us to promote NACA to parents and students. Some of our middle school students are from these schools.
