


ABUNDANT LIFE

Unfortunately, on the way to camp a tire shredded and took out all of the electrical on a van that was already on a salvage title from the hail storm last fall. As a result, we had to let the van go the salvage yard which means we are now short a 7- passenger van. It was this van that we used to transport students to drop off points to go home and High School students to the local community college for classes during the week. It is a loss that has affected us quite a bit.

In addition, our 15-passenger vans have over 200,000 miles on them. We realize they can't run forever.

Would you please pray with us as we praise God for His provisions? Would you be so bold as to ask for Him to provide once again to meet our transportation needs? We are looking for another 7-passenger van and possibly a mini-bus that we can use for sports teams on away games.

At least seven of our staff members were part of Work & Witness teams to NACA before coming on staff. Our staff does not receive any benefits or retirement and sign a statement acknowledging that there may be times when paychecks are late due to low funding.

CROSS COUNTRY

The Native American Christian Academy cross country team competed in two different conferences for our middle school: the Desert Pines League (DPL) and the Nava-Hopi Athletic Junior High League (NHAL). In addition we also introduced High School sports for our upper grade students. As with any sports season, there were highs and lows to the cross country season at NACA. There were some very strong individual performances and improving team participation.

The NACA Junior Varsity team finished third in the Desert Pines Conference Meet. Participants were led by Kayden Isaac's 2nd place finish. NACA also competed at the middle school level in the Nava-Hopi Athletic Junior High League. Though we did not win trophies in that league, a couple of our teams finished 4th in a few meets. The girls' junior varsity team finished 4th three times including in the Final NHAJHL Meet. Top 10 finishes in the NHAJHL were garnered by Jeremiah Isaac in the varsity division and top 15 finishes by Kayden Isaac in the junior varsity division.

Our high school cross country team had two meets, both dual meets with Holbrook Indian School. Noah O'Riley, running strongly, won both meets. Jessica Villalba ran second overall and first among girls. Tristin Dailey rounded out the team with a 3rd and a 4th place finish for the two meets. It was the first high school competition in any sport for many years, and these few students made it a great success.
